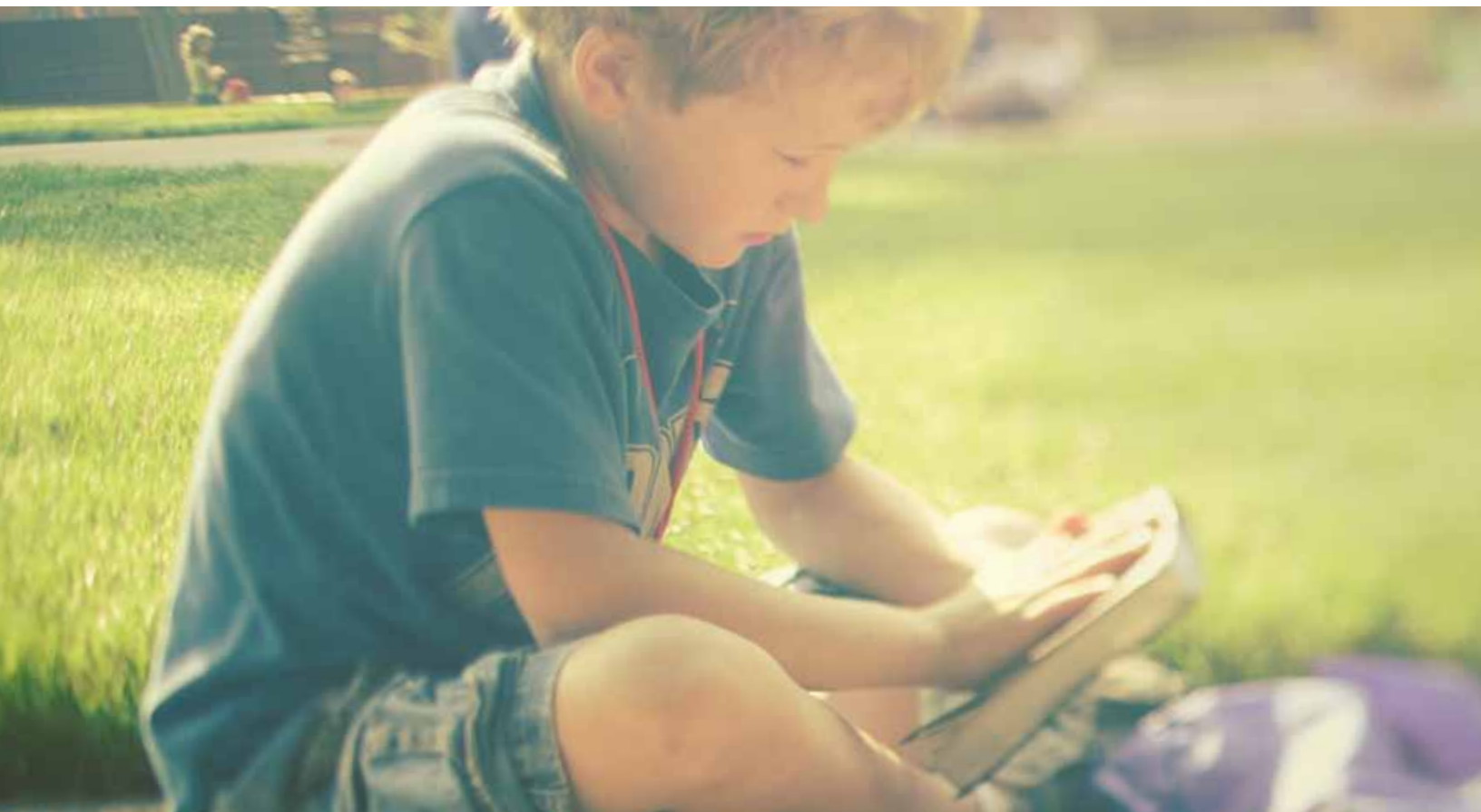

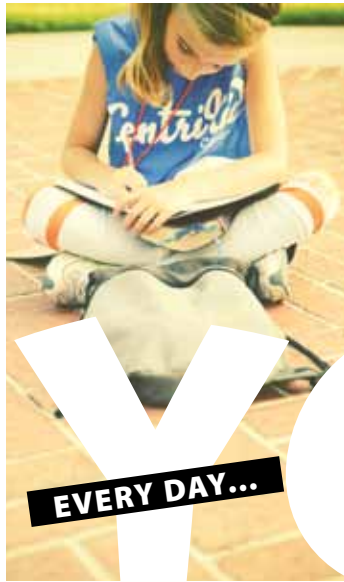
## KID-FRIENDLY PROGRAMMING

## MORE INFORMATION ABOUT REGISTERING FOR CENTRIKID

### February 15, 2011

A \$50 per person deposit is required for each reservation to be paid on or before February 15, 2011. If you have already registered, you are required to pay a \$50 deposit per person to hold your reservation. Any new or additional reservations made after February 15, 2011 will require an immediate \$50 deposit per person. ALL deposits are non-refundable and cannot be applied toward balance due.

### May 1, 2011: Cancellation Deadline

All cancellations made after May 1 will incur an additional \$50 fee for each person dropped. When cancellations occur, deposits cannot be applied toward balance due.

### **14 Days Prior to Camp**

Final balance must be received 14 days before your arrival at camp. If not received, your group will be charged a one-time late fee of \$75.

### **Auto Payment Option**

Authorized Group Leaders may give permission to charge the remaining balance to a church LifeWay account by calling LifeWay Events Registration at 1.877.CAMP123. This must be done by May 1, 2011. Any adjustments for drops or additions will be applied to the specified account after camp.
